Booking a place for Mass

As the weeks go by, I am hoping that the numbers attending Mass, will begin to increase. This means that it will become more important to book your place, especially for weekends. Please be willing to go to alternative Mass times to spread the numbers.

Capacity at Ss Peter and Paul is 65 and at St Joseph the Worker is 45.

Key things to note:

- Social distancing must be observed at all times
- We encourage you to wear face masks/coverings. **(This has not yet become compulsory but with the changes that took place on Friday with shops, it is probably only a matter of time)**
- Please follow instructions of the stewards - especially at Communion and at the end of Mass.
- There will be no singing.
- Collection - a basket will be available at the back but we do encourage people to consider setting up a standing order. Envelopes will go to the relevant parish and the loose plate will be split 50/50.
- Stewards will guide you up for communion.
- After Mass has finished please wait for the stewards to ask your row to leave.

Baptisms

We are now in a position to celebrate the Sacrament of Baptism. They will have to be done under COVID restrictions. This means that we can only have a maximum of **30** people attending. Please contact Fr Neil if you wish to arrange a baptism.

Confessions

The Sacrament of Confession will be celebrated on Saturdays from 11am to 12noon in the sacristy. I am also always happy to hear confessions on request.

Volunteers

If you would be willing to help with stewarding or cleaning, please have a chat with Fr Neil or one of the stewards. This will help to reduce the work load for those already helping.

On behalf of the parish, can I express my thanks to those who have volunteered, as without you we wouldn't be able to have our churches open for Mass.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING FACE MASKS/COVERINGS

As of the 8th August, Face Masks/Coverings will be compulsory in Church. So please do bring a mask or face covering with you. The masks we have been purchased are for those stewarding and cleaning. This is the law of the land, so anyone without a face mask will not be allowed to come in.
