We do so with deep gratitude and joy....It enables us to Worship Almighty God, to support each other on our journey of faith, and to be a visible sign of faith in the world....Attending Mass on Sundays and Holy Days is the greatest of all privileges, sometimes referred to as the Sunday Obligation'
